# Munich Sport Business 2019

Here are the details of the program:

**Dates:** May 12 – 26 (listed as Summer I in Howdy)

**Location:** Germany: Munich & Berchtesgaden  
Austria: Salzburg, Innsbruck, Seefeld and Fuschl am See

**Class:** SPMT 685 Directed Studies for 1 – 3 hours (Do not register yourself – we will do it.)

**Financial Contributions:** The College of Education and Human Development makes a significant financial contribution to reduce the cost in an effort to make this program available to as many students as possible. The CEHD will contribute \$2,000 per student for the **first 20 students who register and confirm participation**. The College is also paying the entire cost of the faculty sponsor(s). There are also scholarships available through the study abroad office, but they are not determined until the spring semester.

**Cost:** The program cost this year is \$2,995 plus tuition, airfare and approximately \$120 in fees to the TAMU Study Abroad Office. The program cost includes \$400 which you will receive in Euros upon arrival in Munich to cover meals that are not included in the program (all breakfasts and a welcome and farewell dinner are included in the program cost). The program cost also includes all room accommodations (very nice 3-star hotels), in-country travel, entrance to all site visits, and excursions. Airfares in the past they have fluctuated between \$900 and \$1,200. So assuming airfare at \$1,000, the total cost of the program is just over \$4,115 (don't forget you'll get \$400 of that back), not including tuition, and less the CEHD contribution described below.

**Total Cost:** With the airfare assumption and CEHD contribution, the total cost will be approximately \$2,115, plus tuition and less the \$400 returned to you, for two weeks doing incredible things in Europe.

**Expected Activities:** Here is a list of the activities we normally schedule, although all of these are not confirmed and could change based on the availability of certain people and venues (photos at bottom):
